



Erosion and Sediment Control Training Local Builders, Developers and Other Interested Trades People Tuesday 1 December 2009

Builders, Developers and other Trades People have a responsibility under the Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997 to prevent stormwater pollution and protect our local waterways. People who fail to provide adequate erosion and sediment control on their construction sites may be issued with an on the spot fine or an environmental protection notice.

To raise awareness and develop the knowledge and skill of local Builders, Developers and other Trades People in implementing effective erosion and sediment controls Ballina Shire Council is hosting a **FREE** training course.

The major areas covered by the course will include:

- Environmental impact of sediment
- The laws in relation to erosion and sediment control and overview

- Erosion and sediment control tools – hay bales, sediment fences, saudades
- Erosion and sediment control – the paperwork
- Common problems on building and development sites
