To arrange for your event to be listed follow the link "submit your event" on **www.discoverballina.com** at the bottom of the page within the Site Map. Staff will approve and upload your event automatically subject to all criteria being met.

The What's On Board is located in a prominent position in the Ballina Visitor Information Centre. The board is updated daily by staff and displays upcoming events, workshops, exhibitions and weather for visitors and locals through the centre. Please provide centre staff with an A4 poster for the What's On board.

Event promotional collateral such as flyers, brochures and programs can be distributed through the Ballina Visitor Information Centre. As event promotional collateral is produced and delivered to the centre it will be displayed appropriately and promoted by staff.
