Angels Beach Drive asphalt overlay to end a four-month project

Roundabout construction at the Angels Beach Drive and Links Avenue intersection is nearing completion with the alternate routes that have been in place this week to continue through to Tuesday 2 August 2016.

To finalise this important black-spot project, the roundabout construction zone will be **re-closed for the final application of asphalt from Monday 8 through to Thursday 11 August.**

Traffic will be diverted as follows (see map below):

- Ballina traffic to and from Lennox Head use The Coast Road.
- North Angels Estate and Silver Gull Drive Estate motorists use The Coast Road.
- East Ballina (Lakeside) motorists **heading towards Ballina Island** can use Angels Beach Drive.
- East Ballina (Lakeside) motorists **heading towards Lennox Head** will need to use The Coast Road via the Manly Street intersection.

The asphalt overlay will mark the end of a four month project. Council thanks motorists for their continued patience and understanding.

The Roads and Maritime Service (RMS) identified Angels Beach Drive as a black spot and allocated \$2 million to the upgrade to make this arterial road and intersection safer and prevent future fatalities.
