



Northern Rivers Carpool

The Northern Rivers Carpool (NRC) was first launched in the Northern Rivers in 2010.

From August 2018 the NRC service is being administered by the Community Carpooling Association Inc (CCAI) which is a not for profit organization which encourages the Australian community to share their vehicle whenever possible to cut down on the number of vehicles on the roads at peak times.

The NRC has approximately 2000 members.

The CCAI is working to link up potential carpoolers from the NSW North Coast, NSW Mid North Coast and QLD Gold Coast to improve opportunities for carpoolers wanting to share longer journeys.

What is carpooling?

Carpooling involves two or more people using a common vehicle to share a ride together.

How does carpooling benefit you and the community?

By sharing your travel to work or activities you can:

- Reduce wear and tear on you and your vehicle
- Save money on fuel
- Meet new people
- Help reduce road congestion, making our roads safer
- Reduce your carbon footprint

Cost

The Northern Rivers Carpool will remain free for the time being for carpoolers. The CCAI are reviewing options to allow new features such as drivers sharing travel costs. Any such features will be in addition to the current service.
