

guidelines for

WEDDINGS ON PUBLIC LAND



If you wish to conduct a wedding on public land under Council's control and you want some certainty that your preferred site will be available to you, then you have to make a written application. There is a fee, and Council will need at least 14 days' notice to process your application.

1. What Council needs to know

You need to tell Council the:

- · wedding date and time
- proposed duration of the ceremony
- venue (precise location include a map)
- proposed use of amplified music (if any)
- approximate size of the wedding
- any equipment such as chairs and small domesticscale shade structures.

2. What's not permitted

Council will generally not approve:

- ceremonies longer than 2 hours
- marquees
- wedding receptions
- loud music.

Council cannot approve the use of Crown land that is not under its control, eg nature reserves and vacant Crown land.
