## terms + conditions

#### **AGE CATEGORIES**

BABIES toddlers and babies under the age of two years enter free of charge

CHILD 2-18 years (children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult)

CONCESSION seniors cardholders, student cardholders, pensioners, health care cardholders and people with disabilities

ADULT 18 years and over

FAMILY Two adults + two children, or one adult and three children

#### **SEASON PASSES**

Full season passes will be offered from the start of the season and be available for purchase until 1 October 2018. After this date, 3-month passes can be purchased. Note: all passes (ten ticket, 3-month and full season) can be used at both Alstonville and Ballina pools.

#### **POOL ENTRY**

By entering the Ballina Community Pools each patron agrees to the conditions of entry and all health and safety requirements. Failure to comply with these conditions may result in an individual or group being refused entry or being asked to leave the facility.
